This is the Sand Bagger Classic. We will be playing at Eagles Ridge Golf course, located in Lakewood, New Jersey. #732-901-4900 We have a starting time scheduled for 2:00 pm. The price is \$78.00 which includes golf and cart. There is also a locker room for your convenience.

Eagle Ridge Golf Club features an 18-hole championship golf course with generous fairways and bent grass greens. A natural Pinelands look is maintained throughout the course, presenting breath-taking views and bluffs to complete the visual imagery. A 25,000 square-foot clubhouse offers a well-stocked golf shop, men's and women's locker facilities, and a superb full-service restaurant and bar - The View Restaurant.

### **On Saturday August 7, 2004,**

PKA Golf Outing, defending champ is Dave Fleming. We will be playing at the Pine Barrens Golf course located in Jackson, New Jersey #877-746-3227. We have a starting time scheduled for 12:00 pm. The price is \$82.00 which includes golf, cart and free bucket of balls at the driving range. Since this course opened in 1999 it had ranked as one of south jersey premiere golf courses.

This course was cut from an evergreen forest and provides a secluded feel. An abundance of natural waste areas make this course quite challenging. With little undulation on the fairways or greens, even lies can be expected. The signature hole is #14, a 226-yard, par 3. From the elevated tee, this hole plays over a gorge to a large green. Stretching to 7,112 yards from the back tees, Pine Barrens is truly a test for the good player and has already been used as a qualifying site for the US Open. There is a dining room, bar and a beverage cart.

### **Directions: To Our House**

From Western Pennsylvania: Take Penn Turnpike to New Jersey turnpike and head north. Take 7A exit for I-195. Pay the toll and bear to your right and head East on I-195 towards the jersey shore. Exit at 16 B and head towards Freehold. You are now on county road 537. At the first four way intersection make a left onto 571. ( there are 3 gas stations, fuel up, if need to) Proceed approximately one mile and on your left side is a red two story colonial house # 409.

### **Local Activities**

- We are just 3 miles away from Six Flags Great Adventure in Jackson NJ. This huge complex has Hurricane Harbor, Wild Safari, and some of the wildest and fastest rides in the country.
